

# RPL for the STA Award in Aquatic Teaching – Mermaid and Mono Fin Swimming Qualification

## Instructor upskill:

- Complete two session plans and a session evaluation form
- Complete the MCQ assessment
- Complete the practical teaching components which is evidenced by the tutor completing the 'Tutor Assessed Skills Sheet'
- Complete the practical assessment of a 20-minute mermaid session delivery.

Instructors will need to apply for RPL via the application form and submit a copy of their certificate as well as course details to STA. STA will review all details and grant RPL, STA will then send the learner portfolio with lesson plans and evaluation form within. Learners will need to liaise with a local ATC to enable them to complete the assessment.

## Tutor upskill:

In order to deliver the qualification tutors will need to apply for an additional aquatic discipline to their tutor status via the application form, in order for tutor status to be granted tutors will need to:

- Be an STA Aquatic Tutor
- Hold the STA Award in Aquatic Teaching – Mermaid and Mono Fin Swimming qualification
- Have 50 hours practical teaching experience of mermaid and mono fin swimming.
